



2020 NEW MEMBER ORIENTATION SCHEDULE

Successful completion of New Member Orientation is a requirement for membership in the Fayette County Board of REALTORS®. Article V, Section 4, of the Fayette County Board of REALTORS® Bylaws prescribe that attendance at New Member Orientation must be completed within six (6) months of applying for Board membership. **Failure to do so will result in denial of the membership application.**

The New Member Orientation requirement can be fulfilled by completing both the 2.5 hour Board Orientation program **AND** a 3-hour Code of Ethics class. **BOTH MUST BE COMPLETED** within the prescribed six (6) month timeframe in order to successfully complete this requirement.

Members can sign up for either a classroom or online Code of Ethics class. More information on both can be found on our website at www.FayetteRealtors.com. All but one of the Code of Ethics classes offer three (3) hours of continuing education credit. NAR offers a FREE Code of Ethics class, which carries NO CE credit. All of these classes satisfy the New Member Orientation requirement.

Please note that all students must be **ON TIME and PRESENT for the entire session (both Board Orientation and the classroom Code of Ethics)**. We suggest students arrive not later than 15 minutes before the program begins in order to check in and obtain a seat.
